GROSS MOTOR

- __ Climbs well (24-30 mos.)
- ___ Walks down stairs alone, placing both feet on each step (26-28 mos.)
- ____ Walks up stairs alternating feet with support (24-30 mos.)
- ___ Swings leg to kick ball (24-30 mos.)
- ___ Runs easily (24-26 mos.)
- ___ Pedals tricycle (30-36 mos.)
- ___ Bends over easily without falling (24-30 mos.)

FINE MOTOR

- ____ Makes vertical, horizontal, circular strokes with pencil or crayon (30-36 mos.)
- ___ Turns book pages one at a time (24-30 mos.)
- ____ Builds a tower of more than 6 blocks (24-30 mos.)
- ___ Holds a pencil in writing position (30-36 mos.)
- ___ Screws and unscrews jar lids, nuts, and bolts (24-30 mos.)
- ____ Turns rotating handles (door knob) (24-30 mos.)

LANGUAGE

- ___ Uses pronouns (I, you, me, we, they) (24-30 mos.)
- ___ Understands most sentences (24-40 mos.)
- ___ Recognizes and identifies almost all common objects and pictures (26-32 mos.)
- Shows frustration when not understood by others (28-36 mos.)
- ___ Understands physical relationships (on, in, under) (30-36 mos.)
- __ Can say name, age, and sex (30-36 mos.)
- ____ Uses words to communicate wants and needs (30-36 mos.)
- ___ Knows simple rhymes and songs (30-36 mos.)

Milestones 3-4 years

GROSS MOTOR

- ___ Hops and stands on one foot up to 5 seconds
- ___ Goes upstairs and downstairs without support
- ___ Kicks ball forward
- ___ Throws ball overhand
- __ Catches bounced ball most of the time
- ____ Moves forward and backward
- ___ Uses riding toys

FINE MOTOR

- __ Copies square shapes
- __ Draws a person with 2-4 body parts
- ___ Uses scissors
- __ Draws circles and squares
- ___ Begins to copy some capital letters

LANGUAGE

- ___ Understands the concepts of "same" and "different"
- ___ Has mastered some basic rules of grammar
- ___ Speaks in sentences of 5-6 words
- Asks questions
- ___ Speaks clearly enough for strangers to understand
- ____ Tells stories

COGNITIVE

- __ Correctly names some colors
- ____ Understands the concept of counting and may know a few numbers
- ___ Begins to have a clearer sense of time
- ___ Follows three-part commands
- ___ Recalls parts of a story
- ___ Understands the concept of same/different
- ___ Engages in fantasy play
- ____ Understands causality ("I can make things happen")

SELF- HELP

- Can feed self with spoon without spilling
- ___ Washes and dries hands and face
- ___ Can do simple household tasks (help set the table)
- ___ Can put on simple clothing items, with help for button, zipper, shoelace (jacket, pants, shoes)



Can run a brush or comb through own hair

SOCIAL/EMOTIONAL

- ___ Interested in new experiences
- __ Cooperates/plays with other children
- ___ Plays "mom "or "dad"
- ___ More inventive in fantasy play
- Can stay on topic during conversations
- __ More independent
- ___ Plays simple games with simple rules
- ___ Begins to share toys with other children
- ___ Often cannot distinguish between fantasy and reality
- May have imaginary friends or see monsters

Milestones 4-5 years

GROSS MOTOR

- ___ Stands on one foot for 10 seconds or longer
- ___ Hops, somersaults
- ___ Swings, climbs
- ___ May be able to skip

FINE MOTOR

- __ Copies triangle and other geometric patterns
- __ Draws person with body
- Prints some letters
- Dresses and undresses without assistance

LANGUAGE

- ___ Recalls parts of a story
- ___ Speaks sentences of more than 5 words
- ___ Uses future tense
- ____ Tells longer stories
- ___ Says name and address

COGNITIVE

- __ Can count 10 or more objects
- __ Correctly names at least 4 colors
- ___ Works in small groups for 5-10 minutes
- ____Better understands the concept of time
- ___ Knows about things used every day in the home (money, food, etc.)

SELF-HELP

- ___ Uses fork, spoon independently
- __ Can chew with lips closed
- ___ Goes to the bathroom independently, with reminders
- ___ Undresses independently, may be able to unbutton and unzip



SOCIAL/EMOTIONAL

- ___ Wants to please
- ___ Prefers to be with friends
- ___ More likely to agree to rules
- ____Likes to sing, dance, and act
- ___ Shows more independence
